




COVID-19 IMPACTS

EMPLOYER SENTIMENT

Key issues for region employers are

- re-engaging seasonal workers (seasonal employment dropped 75% from 2019 to 2021)
- recruiting more visible minority workers (13% of workforce)

WORKER SENTIMENT
