Get to Know Your Rep:

Learn About Their Roles and Responsibilities



Identify Hazards:

Identify unsafe conditions and situations, advise on potential solutions



Engage Workers:

Address workers' health & safety concerns. Consult to address any safety related concerns



Inspect Workplace:

Participate in monthly inspections, review trends, develop corrective action



Do Investigations:

Conduct investigations of incidents, near-misses and work refusals



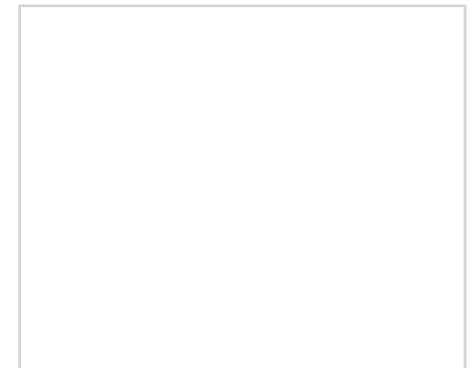
Recommend Improvements:

Suggest ways to enhance workplace health & safety. Advise employer on proposed changes

DID YOU KNOW:

- New members **must** receive **minimum 4 hours of training**
- Employers have **21 days to respond** to recommendations in writing
- If employer refuses recommendations, co-chair can **contact WorkSafeBC to resolve** issue
